# END OF THE GAME

As soon as a player places their third stack face up, they win!

#### MORE WAYS TO PLAY

When you're ready to play a different way, try one of these variations on the game:

**Hor Hands:** Try playing all at the same time! Instead of taking turns, race to swap your cards as fast as you can. When you swap, you must place a card on the Cookie Sheet as soon as you take one.

**Expert Bakers:** If some players need help in the kitchen, try giving older players one or two more stacks of Cookie cards than the younger players when you set up the game.

**Cookie Crazy:** If you have only two or three players, try a longer game. Give each player one or two more stacks of Cookie cards when you set up the game.



### SET UP

- Place the Cookie Sheet in the center of the play area.
- Remove sets of Cookie cards (four of the same character) as follows and return them to the box – they won't be used this game.
  - 2 Players Remove 9 Sets
  - 3 Players Remove 6 Sets
  - 4 Players Remove 3 Sets
  - 5 Players Don't Remove Any
- 3 Shuffle the remaining Cookie cards and place four face up on the Cookie Sheet.
- 4 Deal each player three stacks face down with four Cookie cards in each stack.

The youngest player takes the first turn.

## OBJECT

Be the first to complete three Cookie sets to win! A Cookie set is the same character in each of the four colors.





### ON YOUR TURN

- Pick up and look at one of your three stacks.
- 2 Swap one card from that stack with one card on the Cookie Sheet.
- If that stack is now a complete set
- (four of the same character), those cookies are done! Place that stack face up in front of you and shout, "Ding!"

If that stack is not a complete set yet, place it back in front of you, face down.

Now it's the next player's turn.
